Operation and Maintenance

On-going Maintenance

Brush sprouts in wave berms treated at 16 sites during June by Hall Bros. \$2509.80 cost reimbursed from TSSWCB O&M program.

Summer site inspections conducted during six-week period from late June to early August to check condition of dams and determine weed control and mowing needs for remainder of 2020 and for spring 2021. All dams in good operating order.

Site 17A erosion due to livestock trailing at corner of perimeter fence along auxiliary spillway and dam entrance was repaired by Heartland Construction August 1.

Access/Easement Road Repairs

Site 4: refurbishment of existing road completed by Sohns Construction June 26.
Site 34 (Sevcik/Carpentier) repair and stabilization completed by Hall Bros June 19.
Site 14GSS and Site 13R: access entrances to TSSWCB funded repairs at two sites completed by Espinoza Fencing August 11. These will remain as permanent entrances available to ECWA for future use.

Downstream Erosion – Site 13R

Property owner downstream from Site 13R (Johnny Dokupil, on behalf of Jeanette Bedrich) requested consideration to address erosion in channel cutting into pasture about 200 feet south of point where it enters the branch of Little Elm Creek. Search of files revealed that the easement on Bedrich property included construction of a channel approximately 1334 feet in length, with an aluminum toe wall drop structure near the outlet, if needed. The channel was constructed in 1992, but no drop structure was installed. I recommend requesting survey and design assistance from NRCS to determine if a toe wall would be appropriate now to provide a stable outlet for the channel and the estimated cost to install.

TSSWCB Repair Program

Plunge Basin and Rock Chute Repairs

Site 13R, 14GSS, 15: Work completed as of August 11 at Site 14 on rock chute grade stabilization structure in the flowage easement downstream. This is first of three repair jobs under contract with DJ Hansen Construction, Ephraim, Utah. The second job is now underway to repair and install rock protection to the plunge basin at Site 13R, which should be completed in about 30 days. The final job in the contract will follow on the plunge basin at Site 15. Work is proceeding ahead of schedule. The contractor has submitted an invoice for work completed to date (\$101,664). ECWA will be responsible for 5% of the amount.

Sites 26, 31, and 32: After discussion with TSSWCB staff, a decision was made to delay the solicitation for this set of repairs until services of NRCS project engineer and construction inspector could be secured. The solicitation should be posted and contract awarded as repairs at Site 15 are wrapping up. Based on progress of the first contract, we should be posting the solicitation around the last week of August, with site showing around second week of September, and bid opening last week of September. Anticipate notice to proceed around October 15. The performance time for completing the work is estimated to be 154 calendar days, not including holidays or weather days.

Dam Upgrades

TSSWCB has indicated that contracting for upgrades at the first couple of dams could be on track for spring 2021. ECWA will need to acquire additional easements before the construction funds are approved. Researched existing easements for Site 23 and Site 39. Determined an estimated 7.5 acres of new easement on three properties will be needed at Site 23 with the currently proposed upgrade measures. The Panda gas pipeline easement would also be involved.

About 2.5 acres of additional easement would be needed for the upgrade measures at Site 39, all of which are on the same property owner.

The general manager would like board approval to initiate informal discussion with property owners toward easement agreements.

NRCS WFPO Program

Remedial Repairs

All federally funded remedial repairs have been completed. Wave berm repairs and rock protection was completed at Site 22 as of July 20. Final invoice from Leaday Construction is \$228,823.

Watershed Operations Funding Opportunity for Backlog Dams

Worked with NRCS planning staff over the past few months as an investigation was made to update feasibility of two remaining sites in the Cottonwood Creek subwatershed. The outcome was that the update feasibility process was not adequate to address status of these sites for the funding of design and construction. Consequently, this week the Texas NRCS watershed planning staff submitted a \$350000 WFPO funding request for a supplemental watershed plan for Sites 6R2 and 7 Rev. as the funding opportunity for FY2020 closes on August 15. The supplemental plan will update hydrology and hydraulics, NEPA (environmental compliance), cultural resources, and project benefits. The supplemental plan would guide the board in decisions regarding potential construction of the sites. There is no cost to ECWA.

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ELM CREEK WATERSHED AUTHORITY OFFICIAL MINUTES August 13, 2020

Elm Creek Watershed Authority, Board of Directors, met in regular session on August 13, 2020, at 19 South 25th Street, Suite 500, Temple, Texas

The meeting was called to order by Daniel C. Lesikar, Chairman, at 7:30 p.m.

Consent Agenda: Arvell Jungmann made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes as mailed. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

Income and Disbursements were read aloud by Tricia Mackie. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to receive, approve and file income and disbursements for July. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed. A motion was made by Robert Fleming to receive, approve and file income and disbursements for August. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Tricia Mackie reviewed the 2020 Budget. No action taken.

Tricia Mackie reviewed the 2nd Quarterly Report. Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the report. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Watershed Report: The watershed report was presented by Calvin Sanders. O&M: Brush has been spot treated. Dams have been inspected for O&M needs-all in good operating condition. Erosion from livestock trailing on Site 17A has been repaired.

Access/Easement Roads: Site 4 & 34 access road repairs-completed. Site 13R & 14 access entrances have been installed and will remain as permanent entrance for ECWA.

Downstream Crossings: Landowner on Site 13R has requested ECWA consider repairs from erosion downstream. Mr. Sanders recommends ECWA ask NRCS for assistance in surveying and design to repair erosion.

TSSWCB Programs: Site 14 repairs completed, contractor now working on Site 13R and follow-up with repairs on Site 15 to complete the project. Repairs on Sites 26, 31 & 32 has been delayed in order to utilize inspector from ongoing project. IFB will be solicited at the end of August.

Dam Upgrades: TSSWCB is on track for funding upgrades of dams in spring 2021. ECWA will need additional easements for construction to begin. Mr. Sanders asked the board for authorization to discuss easements with landowners. The board agreed for Mr. Sanders to conduct inquiries with landowners for additional easements.

NRCS Programs: Wave berm repairs on Site 22 have been completed with final invoice ready for approval to pay. Feasibility studies of Site 6R2 and 7R has been deemed "not adequate" to address status of these sites for design and construction funding. NRCS has submitted a fund request for supplemental watershed plan for FY2020, including updates of hydrology and hydraulics, NEPA and other resources and benefits. This plan would guide ECWA in decisions for possible construction.

A motion was made by Robert Fleming to approve the watershed report. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

2021 Budget: A motion was made by Bobby Henson to approve the 2021 Budget as proposed. The motion was second by Arvell Jungmann. Motion passed.

2020 Tax Rate: Steve Rieves made a motion to propose the 2020 tax rate at 0.0327. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Adjourn: Arvell Jungmann made a motion to adjourn. Mike Maedgen second the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
