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### ELM CREEK WATERSHED AUTHORITY Monthly Report – 2/8/2024

### **Operation and Maintenance**

Mowing: Reimbursement payment received.

**Site 21 – Recurring beaver problem:** Second beaver caught. Updated invoice received from Heartland Construction submitted for payment. Will then be submitted to SWCB and TSSWCB for reimbursement.

**Site 25** – Located in Milam County may have beaver problem. Contacted USDA, no trapper in Milam County will cost ECWA \$250.00 per trip for a trapper to come up. Usually takes 4 trips. Will go and check for signs of beaver.

Site 14 – Possible beaver issue land owner said he would take care of it.

### TSSWCB Dam Repair/Upgrade Program

**Site 23-** Erosion downstream at both Stilling Basin area and also downstream at old gravel filter. Email Karen Green and was advised to fill in and grass over. Meet with Tom Beach at site who said he could work up some plans that I could use to get work done.

**Site 23 – Road work.** Working with Mike Northcut and Karen Green NRCS and USDA to get help on design to deal with runoff from field and auxiliary spillway that floods road location. Also found erosion below outlet basin after current rainfall. Located old culverts that are plugged up. Recently found erosion damage below outlet basin. Sent pictures to Ms. Green asking for help.

**Site 23 – Gravel Cleanup.** Working on locations to put gravel after removing from sites. To put at road location?

**Site 23 – Gate on Crews Property**. At new location of fence. H-Braces are in place for 16ft Gate. Espinoza Fencing gave price of \$550 to provide red gate and install at location.

**Site 39:** Work is progressing on site 39. ACECOM and M&E Consultants are working with them on submittals and daily reports. Working 6 days a week when weather allows. Mod for larger slide gate approved. Having to pump water out of borrow area. Processed two invoices from

Patin Construction and sent off for reimbursement. Received third invoice and waiting for payment to be able to send off for reimbursement.

**Site 13R:** Meet with Mr. Coufal at his home along with grandson. Showed him copy of Operation and Maintenance Agreement for Elm Creek (Cen-Tex) Watershed dated Jan 1983 that he had signed. He is wanting to put the Duck Blind on floats and move off the embankment and pull back adjacent to embankment during season. I told him I would need a letter of request from him for the Feb 8 Board Meeting. After receiving a letter from Mr. Coufal trying to change the facts. I have decided that the only way to deal with the issues is to send a Demand Letter through attorney.

### Solar Project and ECWA Easements

**Sites 26, and 31.** Meet with Surveyor with M&E Engineering to get GPS Survey points on dams as part of possible upgrade from Low to High Hazard. Drive access route on Site 26 and had to go off designated access to avoid debris in road. Contacted Five Well Solar and Engie Solar to get cleaned up. Drove access route on Site 26 later and was okay

**Site 26 Amendment for Crossing Easement:** Received First Amendment to Crossing Agreement from Five Wells Solar Center LLC for change in location of crossing. Original Crossing Agreement between ECWA and Five Wells had a Maximum Allowable Variance or not more than 100ft as depicted in Exhibit C. The original Exhibit C showed electrical conduits crossings near each other going under the flowage easement of Site 26. Under the Amendment the Exhibit C shows the electrical conduits crossing farther apart and outside the 100ft variance so a new Amendment needs to be signed. Went out to site on Wednesday Feb 7, 2024 to look at conduits. Contacts Sonny Taunton and Callie Thomason took me to location below dam off ECWA easement, and did not know about other easements even after showing them map. Waiting for reply from Five Wells Solar.

## ELM CREEK WATERSHED AUTHORITY OFFICIAL MINUTES February 8, 2024

Elm Creek Watershed Authority, Board of Directors, met in regular session on February 8, 2024, at 19 South 25<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 500, Temple, Texas

**Directors present:** Ray Jungmann, Arvell Jungmann, Brian Hoelscher, Daniel C. Lesikar, Mike Maedgen, Jerry Lancaster, John Perryman, and Bobby Henson

Others present: Murray McCarley and Tricia Mackie

The meeting was called to order by Daniel C. Lesikar, Chairman, at 7:00 p.m.

Public Comment: None.

**Field Manager Position:** Murray McCarley submitted his resignation. The board discussed the open position with Seth Byers. A motion was made by Arvell Jungmann to offer the position to Mr. Byers and John Perryman second the motion. The motion was amended to include pay at \$35/hr., 6 month probation period and 2/3 healthcare effective immediately by Bobby Henson. Ray Jungmann second the amendment. Amended motion passed.

**Consent Agenda:** Minutes: Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes as mailed. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

Income and Disbursements were read aloud by Tricia Mackie. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to receive, approve and file income and disbursements. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

**Watershed Report:** The watershed report was presented by Murray McCarley. O&M: Beaver has been an issue on a couple of sites with the county trapper working to capture and remove the animals, and one landowner working to remove the animals on his property.

Site Updates 23-Mr. McCarley is working with NRCS to design a road with culverts, etc. to reroute the water runoff from the fields. Erosion on the downstream area from recent rains has become a problem. Mr. McCarley is working with Tom Beach to create a plan to correct the issue. Espinoza Fence submitted an estimate of \$550.00 to purchase and install a gate on the Erskine fenceline. Bobby Henson made a motion to accept the bid from Espinoza Fence to purchase and install the gate. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed. 39-Ongoing construction. 13R-Letter from Ed Coufal concerning removal of duck blind. The board asked Mr. McCarely to contact attorney and send a demand letter to have the blind removed.

Solar Project Requests: Sites 26 & 31-Mr. McCarley is working with engineer to see about upgrading dams to High Hazard.

Amendment to Easement Crossings on Site 26: Met with solar company employees to discuss and locate the crossings, employees did not know where the crossings were located. Mr. McCarley told employees to get the information and get back with him.

Affidavits for Solar Farms: Letters have been prepared and sent.

A motion was made by Bobby Henson to approve the watershed report. Brian Hoelscher second the motion. Motion passed.

ECWA Website: Mrs. Mackie is working to put information together for submittal.

Adjourn: Arvell Jungmann made a motion to adjourn. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
