ELM CREEK WATERSHED AUTHORITY Monthly Report – 3/11/2021

Operation and Maintenance

On-going Maintenance

Fence replacement funded through TSSWCB O&M grant program at Site 10 completed. Installed signs and locked gates to deter vandalism and trespass.

Bids opened for spring maintenance. Fertilization (12 sites covering 170.2 acres) and broadleaf weed treatment (19 sites covering a total of 254.3 acres) awarded to Heartland (Nelson Hall). Mowing (15 sites covering 141.5 acres) divided among Heartland Construction and TerraSol (Ken & Ryan Hall). TSSWCB O&M grant program funding is approved for these maintenance activities.

Funding approved for fence replacement at Site 11 and Site 19 through the TSSWCB O&M grant program. Invitation for bids will go out later this month.

Stream crossings and flowage easement erosion control

The NRCS state office will be initiating survey and design for crossings downstream from Site 5A and Site 24 and an erosion control structure in the flowage easement downstream from Site 13R. Designs and cost estimates should be ready within a couple of months. ECWA showed the locations to survey crew on March 10, 2021. These projects will be funded by ECWA, but can be claimed as in-kind credit toward local 10% share of future TSSWCB O&M program activities, if completed after August 31, 2021.

Dam Safety

Formal TCEQ 5-year dam safety inspections were completed at Sites 23, 28, and 30 with NRCS dam safety engineer Todd Marek. The only remaining inspection is for Site 39 in Falls County. This will be conducted by TCEQ later this year.

Annual review and updates of Emergency Action Plans for each high and significant hazard dam were completed this month as required by TCEQ.

TSSWCB O&M Program Agreement with Central Texas SWCD

The Central Texas Soil and Water Conservation District has submitted an agreement for renewal that would continue allowing ECWA to pursue and expedite participation and funding through the TSSWCB Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Grant Program. In return ECWA would continue to share the 5% reimbursement for administration 50-50 with the SWCD. The agreement is for two years.

TSSWCB Repair Program

Plunge Basin Repairs/Pipe replacement (Site 32 only)

Sites 26, 31, 32: Site 26 completed as of January 14. Site 31 completed as of March 8 and invoice has been submitted for partial payment in the amount of \$142,941.75 for ECWA board approval. Work underway at Site 32, which includes repair and rock protection of the plunge basin and replacement of 50 feet of pipe and pipe support.

Sites 37, 38, 43: Invitation for Bids process underway and plan to advertise around April 1 and start work around early to mid-May. This all depends on completion of the 26, 31, 32 contract and availability of NRCS project engineer and construction inspector.

Dam Upgrades Site 23 and 39

Designs for upgrades at Sites 23 and 39 are near completion. The TSSWCB has sent agreements for each site setting up the State funds for the projects. Below are latest figures:

Proposals for agreements to acquire additional easements have been made by the four property owners at Site 23. The ECWA board will need to consider these proposals and respond to property owners. Agreement documents will be prepared for signature by owners and ECWA. ECWA will need to arrange for metes and bounds survey of the additional easement areas. Once actual acreage is determined, payments to owners and signing of easement documents will be necessary.

The meeting was called to order by Daniel C. Lesikar, Chairman, at 7:01 p.m.

Consent Agenda: Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes as mailed. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

Income and Disbursements were read aloud by Tricia Mackie. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to receive, approve and file income and disbursements for February 2021. Mike Maedgen second the motion. Motion passed. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to receive, approve and file income and disbursements for March 2021. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Watershed Report: The watershed report was presented by Calvin Sanders. O&M: Fence replacement has been completed on Site 10. Bids for spring O&M have been received with award for contract with multiple contractors, with funding available through TSSWCB. Site 11 & 19 fence replacement funding by TSSWCB has been approved with IFB going out in late March.

NRCS will be working on survey and designs for downstream crossings on Sites 5A & 24, along with erosion control downstream on Site 13R. If the work is completed after August 2021, ECWA could receive in-kind credit toward funding from TSSWCB.

Dam safety inspections have been completed on Sites 23, 28 & 30, with Site 39 to be completed later this year.

EAP review and updates have been completed for each high hazard & significant hazard dam.

A renewal agreement for TSSWCB O&M Grant Program has been submitted by Central Texas SWCD for funding. Mr. Sanders suggested ECWA cost-share the 5% reimbursement of administration costs with the SWCD for 2 years. A motion to approve the 50-50 cost-share agreement with Central Texas SWCD for 2 years was made by Mike Maedgen. Bobby Henson second the motion. Motion passed.

Repairs on Site 32 are ongoing with Sites 26 & 31 completed. ECWA received an invoice for partial payment on the contract in the amount of \$142,941.75. IFB for repairs on Sites 37, 38 & 43 will be released at the beginning of April. Mike Maedgen made a motion to pay the invoice for Site 26, 31 & 32 repairs in the amount of \$142,941.75 to Leaday Construction. The motion was second by Bobby Henson. Motion passed.

Sites 23 & 39 dam upgrade designs are near completion. Agreements for funding will be provided by TSSWCB. Land rights will be the responsibility of ECWA. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to approve the agreements for funding for Sites 23 & 39 dam upgrades. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Robert Fleming to approve the watershed report. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Easements: Site 23-Mr. Sanders discussed the proposals received from landowners. Costs will vary due to actual acres as adjusted by metes and bounds. Robert Fleming made a motion to accept the terms and costs to acquire additional easements as proposed by landowners. \$15,000 per acre plus detailed damages. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Site 39-No proposal received from the landowner. Arvell Jungmann made a motion to offer the landowner \$15,000 per acre plus damages. Bobby Henson second the motion. The board asked Mr. Sanders to submit the offer by mail. Motion passed.

ECWA Website: Mrs. Mackie discussed the opinion of the attorney, no website required at this time. No action taken.

Notice to Purchaser: Mrs. Mackie informed the board of the information received from the attorney, ECWA has no obligation to complete or offer this form to any landowner. No action taken.

Director Vacancy: Mrs. Mackie discussed the need for the board to appoint an individual to fill the vacant position.

Adjourn: Arvell Jungmann made a motion to adjourn. Mike Maedgen second the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
