## ELM CREEK WATERSHED AUTHORITY Monthly Report – 10/8/2020

#### **Operation and Maintenance**

#### **On-going Maintenance**

TSSWCB O&M program funds (\$12976) approved or fall mowing at 20 sites covering 197 acres. Heartland Construction is lined up to do the work in November.

Applications for TSSWCB O&M program funds made and approvals received for spring 2021 O&M activities including fertilization, mowing and weed spraying totaling \$44039. An application was also submitted for replacement of remaining original fence at Site 37 to be done once plunge basin repairs completed next spring.

Treated brush sprouts at Sites 21, 22 and 23. Eight more sites scheduled for treatment this month with sprouts either on dam and spillway or in wave berm.

#### **Dam Safety**

Received notification alerts from Dam Watch program following early September heavy rainfall event at 16 dams in the watershed. The alerts are generated automatically when Doppler radar-indicated rainfall reaches a prescribed threshold. Conducted visit of all sites and worked with NRCS to respond online to describe the conditions at each site and cancel the ticket.

#### **TSSWCB Repair Program**

#### Plunge Basin Repairs

Site 13R plunge basin repair and rock protection completed. Work is underway at Site 15 and should be completed by the first week of November. No payment request has been submitted since the September meeting.

Sites 26, 31, and 32: Bids from five contractors opened on September. Low bidder is Leaday Construction LLC, College Station, TX. Contract Agreement has been sent to contractor for signature. Notice to proceed is tentatively set for November 9, but could be sooner. This contract is for repair and installation of rock protection in plunge basins at each of the three sites, as well as replacement of 50 foot section of pipe and pipe support at Site 32.

#### Dam Upgrades

Design concept for Site 4 upgrade presented by AECOM to ECWA, TSSWCB and NRCS via web conference on September 22. The design calls for raising top of dam elevation, raising auxiliary spillway elevation by about a foot, replacing the principal spillway inlet and conduit with a larger size, and installing a roller compacted concrete spillway in the embankment near the location of the current principal spillway. AECOM engineers indicate that the elevation changes will allow the designed storm to pass through the structure without needing to acquire additional easement for floodwater detention. There will be need for additional easement for extending the dam embankment to the new top of dam elevation and for the RCC spillway channel.

Letters and information were sent to owners at Site 23 and Site 39 where additional easements are required for upgrades. Each letter describes the existing dam, reasons the upgrade is necessary, components of the upgrade, and additional easement areas needed for upgrade measures. The letters emphasize that the ECWA board priority is to reach agreements with owners to acquire the easements and requested that owners reply with proposed terms for an agreement.

#### **NRCS WFPO Program**

No new information on application for supplemental watershed planning since the August meeting.

The meeting was called to order by Daniel C. Lesikar, Chairman, at 7:30 p.m.

**Consent Agenda:** Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the public hearing minutes as mailed. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed. Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes as mailed. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

Income and Disbursements were read aloud by Tricia Mackie. A motion was made by Bobby Henson to receive, approve and file income and disbursements. Dean Mikeska second the motion. Motion passed.

Tricia Mackie reviewed the 2020 Budget and suggested decreasing Travel \$2500 and increasing Payroll \$2500. Mike Maedgen made a motion to amend the 2020 Budget as suggested. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

Tricia Mackie reviewed the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report. Bobby Henson made a motion to approve the report. Dean Mikeska second the motion. Motion passed.

**Watershed Report:** The watershed report was presented by Calvin Sanders. O&M: Funding from TSSWCB has been approved for mowing this fall on 20 sites. TSSWCB applications have been submitted and approved for fertilizer, mowing and weed control for spring 2021. Replacement fence for Site 37 funding has been submitted to TSSWCB. Brush has been treated on Sites 21, 22, & 23, with more sites scheduled.

Dam Safety: Dam Watch signaled alerts during the September rain event at 16 sites. Mr. Sanders inspected the sites and has worked with NRCS on response to the alerts.

Repairs: Site 13R repairs have been completed. Site 15 is scheduled to be completed in early November. Bid opening for Site 26, 31 & 32 repairs were conducted in September with Leaday Construction awarded the contract and start date of November 9<sup>th</sup>.

Dam Upgrades: Designs for Site 4 to raise the dam elevation have been submitted. Additional easements will be required for extending the dam embankment. Letters have been sent to landowners of sites 23 & 39 for additional easements. Letters ask landowners to propose terms for agreement with ECWA for additional easements.

NRCS Programs: No new information at this time.

A motion was made by Bobby Henson to approve the watershed report. Dean Mikeska second the motion. Motion passed.

**Investment Policy:** A motion to adopt the 2020-2021 Investment Policy by resolution was made by Mike Maedgen. The motion was second by Ray Jungmann. Motion passed.

**Investment Officer:** Mike Maedgen made a motion to appoint by resolution Bobby Henson as the 2020-2021 Investment Officer. Ray Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed.

Adjourn: Dean Mikeska made a motion to adjourn. Arvell Jungmann second the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:57 p.m.
