Operation and Maintenance

On-going Maintenance

Applied for TSSWCB O&M program funds for fall mowing at 20 sites covering 197 acres.

An announcement of O&M program funding opportunity should be released soon for O&M work to be completed from September 2020 through August 2021. We will make applications for spring O&M activities including fertilization, mowing and weed spraying.

TSSWCB Repair Program

Plunge Basin Repairs

Work is proceeding at Site 13R to repair plunge basin and install rock protection. The work is on schedule to be completed in the next 2-3 weeks, but could be delayed now due to rain. Site 15 is the final plunge basin to be repaired under this contract. A partial payment request of \$50331 has been submitted and pending NRCS approved for work completed through August 31. ECWA is responsible for 5% of the cost of construction.

Sites 26, 31, and 32: Solicitation was posted on civcastusa.com last week. Site showing is September 16 and bid opening on September 30. This contract is for repair and installation of rock protection of plunge basins at each of the three sites, as well as replacement of 50 foot section of pipe and pipe support at Site 32.

Dam Upgrades

Contacted Frank Benolken, owner at Site 39, regarding need for additional easement. He is very cooperative and I believe we can work out an agreement. He is interested in development of water sources (stock tanks) in a couple of adjacent pastures. He would like to see if borrow sources could be designated that would remain as livestock water source.

After asking the engineering firm to investigate realignment of the auxiliary spillway at Site 23, a new concept was developed that reduced the amount of new easement needed and also will almost entirely avoid the Panda gas pipeline easement. Only a small amount of earth fill would cover the pipeline and there would be no excavation in that location. This information was shared with Ed Coufal and we will be meeting soon to discuss potential agreement for additional easement.

Investigations are planned for next week at Site 4. A concept design has not been provided for upgrade measures as yet, but there is indication that a roller compacted concrete spillway could be included. Additional drilling is proposed where the RCC would be positioned and channel constructed to tie in with existing creek.

NRCS WFPO Program

No new information on application for supplemental watershed planning since the August meeting.
